Terms of Reference for Neighbourhood Plan committee

Objective.

To document the views of parish residents as they relate to the following subject areas;

Infrastructure development and maintenance

Preservation and enhancement of Biodiversity

Housing development

Provision and maintenance of amenities

Approach.

Determine appropriate deliverable(s) – eg, Neighbourhood plan and/or priority statement and/or parish action plan and/or Village design statement etc.

By subject area, identify resources required to deliver – eg; Budget, People, Other?

Document the outline principles, policies, constraints etc relevant to the subject areas.

Consult with parish residents

Document results of consultation, summarise findings, determine 'vision' statement and produce document.

Gain document approval from the community

Scope.

The committee will consider matters as they relate to Barcombe parish council boundary.

Policies, principles and constraints for each subject area, in addition to matters implicit in the subject itself, will consider impacts on views, green space, flood risk, built heritage, visitors, local employment and sustainability.

Constraints.

The Terms of Reference to be approved by the parish council

Any spend must be agreed by the parish council before commitments are made.

All documentation should conform to an agreed standard (fonts etc), written in plain English and supported with appropriate images where possible.

Document should conform to 'authorising' body standards as appropriate.
